21 Possible Sabbath Activities

- Special Sabbath rituals, such as lighting candles at sundown on Friday night
- Special really fun toys that are used only on Sabbath
- Special food for Sabbath
- Conduct an Interactive Bible study (Designed for the age group doing the study)
- View a video program (examples might include: documentaries on Noah's Ark, Creation vs Evolution, Bible related stories, etc...)
- Draw and/or color Bible, animal, or nature pictures (things related to God and His Creation)
- Walk in Nature where possible
- Sing songs, and play music together

- Enjoy your time together
- Do Bible, and Sabbath-related story telling and reading
- Call a friend on the phone and talk to them about Jesus
- Write to a Missionary working in a far away land
- Do a Christian crossword puzzle
- Do a nature related jigsaw puzzle
- Make a "Thank You" list (count your blessings)
- Study the Bible or Sabbath School Lessons
- Study astronomy and the stars on Friday evening
- Write Bible verses in your own words, and discuss their meanings together
- Create a Bible character game (like the 20 questions game)
- Vary the Bible game above using plants, foods, animals, Biblical events, etc. in place of a character
- Be a blessing to others in need





Get into the Word!

Want to study the Bible but feeling stuck? Here are some ideas!

SOAP METHOD

Study a Bible text or passage using SOAP. Read a verse or passage and then:

- **S** (Subjective)-write how it makes you feel.
- **O** (Objective)—write something factual.
- A (Apply)—write how you could apply the verse to your life.
- **P** (Pray)—write a prayer to God based on the verse.

ALSO CONSIDER...

Word Study Tracing a word and its meaning(s) throughout the Bible

Theme Study

Exploring what the Bible has to say about a particular theme you're interested in.

Parables Study

Explore the parables of Jesus - they are rich in meaning and application!

REFLECTIVE BIBLE STUDY



After reading a portion of the Bible slowly and choosing one or two things or insights that especially helped you, take each insight and ask the following questions:

Adoration: How can I love and praise God on the basis of this? What do I see here that I can praise him for?

Repentance: How do I fail to realize this in my life? What wrong behavior, harmful emotions or attitudes result when I forget this?

Gospel thanks: How can I thank Jesus as the ultimate revelation of this attribute of God (reflected upon in #1) and the ultimate answer to this sin or need of mine (reflected upon in #2)?

Aspiration: How does this show me what I should or could be and do? How would I be different if this truth were powerfully real to me?
